Directions

From Birmingham International Airport

There is a regular train service between the airport and New Street station. The journey time is approx 20 minutes. Follow the directions below to walk to Two Snowhill. Taxis are also available from outside the airport.

Birmingham New Street railway station is a ten-minute walk from our offices. Pass through the ticket barriers on the new concourse, following signs for the 'New Street Exit'. On leaving the station, walk straight ahead up Corporation Street. Turn left on to Upper Bull Street. Walk around Colmore Circus Queensway and then continue down Snow Hill Queensway. Our Offices are located on the left hand side of the road. Alternatively, taxis can be found outside the 'New Street Exit' of the station on Stephenson Street.
